

One Thousand Talents Award Presented by ZJGSU President to Law School's Professor Linton

The President of Zhejiang Gongshang University, Professor Shoucan Chen, recently presented the Law School's Professor Suzannah Linton with an Award Certificate confirming her appointment to the Chinese Government's One Thousand Talents programme.

The One Thousand Talents scheme is aimed at enhancing China's research expertise by recruiting outstanding global talent who can contribute towards the development of Chinese universities, particularly to hone domestic expertise and improve research outputs. In conjunction with the Award, Professor Linton holds the position of Distinguished Professor in the International Law Department of the University's Law School. She is working closely with Vice-Dean Song Jie, on the globalisation of the Law School and strengthening teaching and research in International Law. Professor Linton is the first *international* recipient of the award to be based at Zhejiang Gongshang University.
